3. What steps has God taken to help us fallible, doubting humans become more like Him?
4. So, why did God want to do dwell in the midst of the Israelites?
5. Have you ever tried to hide from your shadow? How come hiding fails?
6. **Relationships Exo 25:8; Lev 26:11-12;** I think Mitchelle should teach this section. Each week we are reminded of such!
7. Why did God command Israel to build the sanctuary?
8. What reason does He give for doing this?
9. How close of a relationship does God want with us?
10. How does the sanctuary help us to be accepted and not abhorred by God?
11. If the sanctuary is so important to fully understand God, why is it so rejected by other “Christians”?
12. **Sin, Sacrifice, and Acceptance Isa. 53:4–12; Heb 9:22; 10:4** What do those verses mean to you? Do we know why Jesus died?
13. Hebrews **10:4, 11** tell us that the blood of bulls and goats can never take away sin. Why then does the blood of Christ accomplish that goal?
14. Is this some kind of mystical or magical transaction that we cannot understand?
15. What does the hymn mean when it says: “wonder-working pow’r in the blood of the Lamb”?
16. Man sinned. We were lost. Jesus restored us through His blood. Is it that easy?
17. **The Substitution Matthew 26:28, Ephesians 2:13, Hebrews 9:14, and 1 Peter 1:19** Did Jesus volunteer to die?
18. Who did He die for?
19. What does it mean that He delivers us from this present, evil world? Is that present tensed or future tense?
20. What would His death accomplish?
21. **The New Covenant High Priest Heb 2:3; 8:1-6** Why is it easier to question God’s will than to go blindly where God leads?
22. When you think of Jesus our Mediator and Minister and Defense Attorney, what does it tell you about how God looks at us?
23. Is Jesus trying to convince the Father of something that the Father does not understand and accept?
24. When Jesus went to heaven, He became our High Priest. So why some churches still have priests today offering incense and offerings?
25. **Heavenly Ministry 1 Tim. 2:5, 6; Heb. 2:10; 4:14-15; 9:24; 1 Pet. 2:24** How did Christ carry our sins in His body to the cross?
26. What two roles does Jesus portray here? How are they related together?
27. What does Jesus being in the Heavenly Sanctuary have to do with our practical life ?”
